Athens and Jerusalem were missing out on life in the Temple (presence and Love) of Yahweh.

[1 Corinthians 9:19-23](#) - Paul worked to translate the Good News for those who are seeking.

Greece collected gods who added to a list of the attributes of the world and ultimate reality. There were still other things “unknown”.

Study is a good thing but not the necessary thing.

In Jesus Christ we can find (what we are looking for) a secure relationship with the One in Whom “we live and move and have our being.”

We now know (because of Jesus Christ) that Yahweh is Love everywhere, all the time. We do not have to fear what we have yet to learn, since we trust that nothing can separate us from the Love of God.

The risen Christ calls us to repent.

Jesus Christ is the measure of human history and the Lord who will keep teaching and working after the Temple is destroyed and the Roman Empire falls.
