### Parsonage

- Use as a parsonage and support a minister without having to use budget funds for the value provided by supplying housing. This also locates the minister in the community.

- Use the parsonage to support a household in need or a missionary on furlough. The rent, if any, can be set as part of the plan for how to utilize housing to provide for their needs and encourage the next steps in their plan for long term support.
